Eyeballs should be removed or product should be returned.

**POSEIDON BEANIE**

Octopus legs should be removed or product should be returned.

Canmore, Alberta (November 28th, 2008) – Ambler Mountain Works Ltd. voluntarily announced a recall of two models of kids' hats – the Erwin and Poseidon Beanies – for possibility of insecurely attached parts. If detached, both parts may present choking hazards. Ambler has received one report from a customer with no injuries. Affected units were limited to units sold between August 2008 and November 2008.

On the Erwin, if the eyeballs are insecurely attached, they may come loose, possibly presenting a choking hazard. On the Poseidon, the same hazard exists with the Octopus legs. **All affected beanies should be immediately returned to Ambler for a free product replacement. If not returned, then suspect parts should be cut off of the product and permanently disposed of.**
